

## **NCVBDC Lakshadweep (National Centre for Vector Borne Disease Control)**

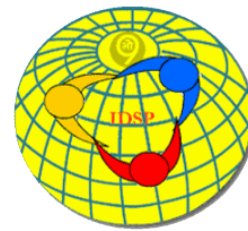

The programme emphasizes surveillance, early diagnosis, prompt treatment, vector control measures, and community participation. Through coordinated public health efforts, NVBDCP Lakshadweep aims to reduce disease transmission and protect the health and well-being of the island population.

## **IDSP Lakshadweep (Integrated Disease Surveillance Programme)**

is a key public health initiative aimed at the early detection and prevention of disease outbreaks in the Union Territory. The programme strengthens disease surveillance through systematic data collection, analysis, and timely reporting. By ensuring rapid response and coordination among health institutions, IDSP Lakshadweep helps safeguard public health and improve preparedness against communicable diseases across the islands.
